PHASE 01 OF THE ICA PROGRAM**Segment 1: The ICA Segment (10th June - 2nd July 2023)**

The International Commercial Arbitration Segment of the Program will be conducted every Saturday and Sunday by practitioners and academics with years of experience and expertise in the field of arbitration. This segment concludes with a Written Assessment, where your knowledge on International Commercial Arbitration will be tested.

Segment 2: The CISG Segment (9th July - 25th July 2023)

The International Sale of Goods (CISG) Segment of the Program will be conducted every Saturday and Sunday by practitioners and academics with years of experience and expertise in the field of commercial law. Participants will be taught the basics of The United Nations Convention for International Sale of Goods (CISG) and would be required to face a written assessment at the end of the segment.

Segment 3: Written Advocacy and Oral Advocacy Segment (29th July - 3rd September 2023)

This segment will cover the basics of Written and Oral Advocacy and will be conducted on Saturday and Sunday. The written advocacy portion will feature classes on researching, drafting, building, and structuring an individual written memorandum.

Participants will be given the opportunity to draft their own memoranda which will be reviewed which will be marked as per the Vis Moot Rules, accommodating different styles of drafting, by experienced coaches and arbitrators.

Through the Oral Advocacy portion, participants will learn the basics of oral advocacy, including building and structuring your arguments and answering arbitrator questions. The classes will include mock moots and practice sessions with Coaches, Arbitrators and Vis Alumni, during which the participants will be able to develop their oral advocacy skills. The segment will conclude with an assessment.
